PROFESSOR MARIA CROTTY

- Clinical academic, Unit head of a rehabilitation unit in Southern Adelaide
- Professor of Rehabilitation, Aged and Extended Care at Flinders University
- Clinical director of the Australian Rehabilitation Outcomes Centre (AROC)

She has conducted trials on health services for older people (including home rehabilitation, transition programs, and outreach to nursing homes) which have transferred into state funded programs. Her research focuses on recovery in older people including patients with dementia.

Key contributions to health services:

- Implementing clinical change and chaired South Australia's Statewide Rehabilitation Clinical Network 2012-14
- Clinical Lead Ministerial Advisory Committees' Transforming Health Rehabilitation Workgroup 2016-18
- Clinical Lead Rehabilitation Country Health South Australia (2013-7)
- A member of the Clinical Advisory Council of South Australia's Commission of Excellence and Innovation in Health.
- Received the Public Service Medal for services to rehabilitation (2018)
- A past president of the Fragility Fracture Network (2014-2015).
